Hi, my name is Debora Katembo and I am 22 years old. My two month old daughter is Sophia Marie Katembo but she goes by Sophie Lee. She is a blessing and I thank God for giving her to me as my daughter. "My daughter you are my little soul, you will be mine to keep safe. I will wrap my arms around you and hold you close."

I heard about the Hope House through a church in Amarillo and I came here on April 23, 2015. I have been here 8 months and I'm grateful to be here. It has changed my life a lot. I did not appreciate who I was and what God had made me to be, so instead of *thanking* God for my two strong legs that are able to run and jump and climb, I whined about my "thunder thighs" and "thick" ankles. Instead of rejoicing that I have two capable arms that can lift and carry and balance my body, I complained about the flab that hung beneath them. I have been totally and unbelievably ungrateful for everything. Like a completely spoiled brat, I took my healthy body for granted. I criticized it and despised it. With crystal clarity, I know that I do *not* deserve the good health that God has mysteriously blessed me with. Not only have I been unappreciative of my body and it's amazing working parts, I tortured it by over exercising, and I put my entire health at serious risk by starving myself. What on earth was wrong with me? As I watch these kids, I feel so thoroughly ashamed of myself. I mean, how I could have been so stupid and shallow and self-centered but the Hope House has been a life saver.

Ever since I have been at the hope house, I have learned so much and changed in so many different ways. For example, I hated people. I did not want to be around anybody. Now I have learned how to love people through the man above and through Monica and Miss Debbie. I am so grateful for them and for the love that they have poured into me and everything they have taught me. I don't know what I would have done without them. My being at the Hope House has also changed the way I think about everything. For instance, when there is a problem I use my brain to solve it instead of letting the problem get worse than it was.
